WAR ARTIST (AUS), placed 6 times at 5 and 6 years, 2009 and £155,351 including second in Golden Jubilee Stakes, Ascot, Gr.1, Duke of York Stakes, York, Gr.2 and Lady Wulfruna Stakes, Wolverhampton, L. and third in July Cup, Newmarket, Gr.1; also won 7 races in France, Germany, South Africa and U.A.E. at 3 to 7 years, 2010 and £219,182 including Mercury Sprint, Clairwood, Gr.1, bestwetten.de Goldene Peitsche, Baden-Baden, Gr.2, Prix du Petit Couvert, Longchamp, Gr.3 and Xpress Al Shindagha Sprint, Meydan, Gr.3 and placed 3 times viz second in Capital Electronics Byerley Turk Plate, Scottsville, Gr.3 and third in Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp, Longchamp, Gr.1 and Golden Horse Casino Sprint, Scottsville, Gr.1.

ROYAL SOLITAIRE (AUS), **won** 2 races at 3 years in Australia and placed 6 times; dam of **4 winners**: **WAR ARTIST (AUS)**, see above.

Sashenka (AUS) (2004 f. by Orientate (USA)), won 3 races at 2 and 4 years, 2008/09 in Australia and placed 5 times including second in Qrse Kaleidoscope Classic CE Mcdougall Stakes, Eagle Farm, L. and Tommy Smith Slipper Stakes, Doomben, L. and third in Inglis Sires' Produce Stakes, Randwick, Gr.1.

VITRUVIAN (AUS) (2002 c. by Spinning World (USA)), **won** 4 races at 2 to 5 years in Australia and placed 3 times.

RADETSKY (AUS) (2005 g. by Falbrav (IRE)), **won** 3 races at 4 years, 2009/10 in Australia, placed 4 times. Soleil Royale (AUS) (2006 f. by French Deputy (USA)), has ran once at 2 years, 2009/10 in Australia. She also has a 2-y-o colt by Jet Spur (AUS).

SANHEDRIN'S PRIDE (AUS) (c. by Sanhedrin (USA)), **won** 10 races in Australia including Sires' Produce Stakes, Ascot, **Gr.2**, fourth in Winfield Perth Cup, Ascot, **Gr.1** and The Rothwells, Ascot, **Gr.1**.

RANCHO MISS (AUS) (f. by Rancher (AUS)), **won** 3 races in Australia including Lyndhurst Eye Liner Stakes, Ipswich, **L.**, placed third in Lightning Handicap, Eagle Farm, **Gr.3**; dam of winners.

Timeless Miss (AUS), 3 races in Australia, second in Sir Douglas Wadley Handicap, Eagle Farm, **L. Kimester (AUS)**, 1 race in Australia, placed third in Queen's Plate, Ascot, **L.**

Francisco Kid (AUS) (g. by El Frances (PR)), won 12 races in Australia and Hong Kong, placed third in Chinese Club Challenge Cup, Happy Valley, L. (twice) and Chairman's Prize, Sha Tin, L. BE A SPORT (AUS), won 11 races in Australia.

Mais Non (AUS), placed twice in Australia; grandam of **Yaya Lad (AUS)**, 6 races in Australia, placed second in Prince of Wales Stakes, Ascot. **Gr.3**.
